Jehova -Sabaoth, Lord of God's armies
Jehovah-Shalom, The Lord who is peace
Jehovah -Tsidkenu, The righteous Lord
Jehovah-Shammah, The Lord who is there.



God's will

Your Kingdom come, your will be done on earth as it is in heaven:

Pray for the following:

Our Country	That we are laborers for the harvest
Our Church	That his will be done in our church body
Our life	That he will teach you to be a servant
Needs of others	That you will see the needs of others.

Gratefulness

Give us this day our daily bread.

Take time to be grateful for what we have. Thank God and worship him for your life and those in it.

Forgiveness

And forgive us our debts, as we also have forgiven our debtors.

Pray you will forgive others and that God will forgive your debts to others and to him from sin. Make it a key point to repair if possible. Thank him for his forgiveness. Don't have anyone owe you or owe them. "For if you forgive others for their transgressions, your heavenly Father will also forgive you. But if you do not forgive others, then your Father will not forgive your transgressions."

And do not lead us into temptation, but deliver us from evil.


Do you know that our choices and our desires can lead us into temptation? Ask God to search your heart for desires that are not aligned with His will.
